

Psittacine Crop Milk Hand Feeding Formula

Use

This product is intended for hand-rearing seed-eating psittacine chicks in the first neonatal phase (from hatching to a maximum age of 7-8 days, depending on the species). This is an exclusive high-concentration and highly digestible hand feeding formula.

Directions for use

It is a complete feed for the hand breeding of birds of the *Psittacidae* family. It is designed to constitute 100% of the parrot's diet.

Especially recommended for professionals using artificial incubation, it promotes optimal chick growth rates similar to those achieved by the best breeding parrots.

Mix with lukewarm water to the indicated concentration at daily intake.

Store in a cool dry place after opening (while refrigeration is not advised, freezing is possible if it is hermetically sealed).

Daily intake

During the first day, increase the concentration with every feeding, from approximately 1% in the first feeding to 20% in the last. From 3rd day, the concentration must be 25%.

Chicks should be fed with the appropriate daily amount depending on their crop capacity, divided over many feedings a day (usually, a minimum of 7-8 feedings a day for the first days).

Composition

Products and by-products of oil seeds and fruits, dried whole egg, vegetable oils, minerals, inulin (0,05%)

Additives

Mixture of flavouring compounds (contains *Yucca schidigera* extract 0,015%); *Tagetes erecta* extract / Sepiolite / Tocopherol-rich extracts of natural origin, palmityl-6-ascorbic acid / Compounds of trace elements (ferrous chelate, cupric chelate, manganese chelate, zinc chelate; calcium iodate anhydrous and hydroxy-analogue of selenomethionine) / Vitamins, pro-vitamins and chemically well-defined substances having similar effects (A, D3, E, C, K, B1, B2, B6, B12, Pantothenic acid, Niacin, Folic acid, Biotin, Choline chloride, Betaine anhydrous)

Moisture 5,0%, Crude protein 44,5%, Crude oils and fats 40,5%, Crude fibres 1,5%, Crude ash 5,3%
